On March 18<sup>th</sup>, the Rockies pulled off one of the biggest surprises for the 2022 baseball season: the signing of the well-coveted Kris Bryant to a seven-year pact for \$182 million. Getting Bryant, the former Cub/Giant, was a huge coup for the ballclub since they had been unable to re-sign free-agent Trevor Story who had turned his back on an \$18.4 million offer in November 2021 to remain in Colorado...Plugged in to leftfield, the year would be a heart-breaking downer for Bryant. He twice spent time on the injured list early in the season with a back ailment. Then in July, he was slowed by plantar fasciitis and a bone bruise in his right foot. The maladies ultimately ended his year. When he was available for duty he was productive. Over 42 games played, he managed to poke five homers and drive in 14 runs while hitting over .300. The Rockies hit a solid .254 (3<sup>rd</sup> in the N. L.); however, Bryant's absence had to be factored in to a power outage which produced 149 home runs, 13<sup>th</sup> in the league. C. J. Cron could head into the off-season with his head high and enthusiastically look to the future following a season of 29 jacks and 102 RBI. Ryan McMahon clobbered 20 homers to compliment Charlie Blackmon's 16 and team leading 78 RBI. Randal Grichuk added 19 round-trippers and 73 runs batted in. Yonathan Daza was a strong offensive contributor, hitting a tad over .300 and excelling defensively to earn regular work in the outfield...The pitching staff gave up slightly more than five earned runs per game--a total of 873 runs for the season. German Marquez and Kyle Freeland both won nine games to top the staff. Marquez had the most strikeouts (150)...The Rockies won only 25 games in the last half of the season.
