First year manager and former A's outfielder Mark Kotsay faced a huge task to find a way to win ballgames with his dugout missing valuable commodities such as Matt Olson, Matt Chapman, and pitcher Chris Bassitt--all among the heart of the team. They had been lost through trades to three different teams. What remained was a group which finished last in the American League with a .216 batting average and second-to-last in runs scored (568). Vet Seth Brown came through nicely, hitting a team-leading 25 homers while driving in 73. One of the game's best defensive catchers, Sean Murphy, was next with 18 jacks and 66 RBI...The pitching staff, 13th in the league with a 4.52 ERA, had no double-digit winners. The end of the season found Cole Irvin holding the most wins (9) and strikeouts (128)...The A's were a combined 30-46 versus division foes.
