The Diamondbacks and sixth-year skipper Torey Lovullo were never contenders for the NL West title. Their high-point of the season was May 13th with a record of 18-15, fourth place in the standings and a mere three games from first. They finished the first half 40-52, the second 34-36. Head-to-head with division opponents, The Snakes were 29-47 (.382). The trio of Christian Walker, Ketel Marte, and 25-year-old Daulton Varsho fashioned fine individual seasons. Walker was seventh in the big leagues with 36 home runs and was awarded his first Gold Glove. Marte tied two others for the sixth-most doubles in the majors (42) while Varsho continues to shine with his versatility and improving power numbers (27 HRs, 74 RBI, 23 doubles). He was runner-up to Walker's 94 RBI for team honors. Merrill Kelly's 13 wins led the pitching staff, but it was Zac Gallen, 26, who posted a sparkling .750 winning percentage (12-4) and ended the campaign second in the majors with a .913 WHIP (Justin Verlander #1 at .829) as well as the best hits allowed/9 innings ratio (5.918). Gallen topped the staff with 192 strikeouts, Kelly punched out 177 for the year. Nick Ahmed's shoulder injury from 2020 alarmingly persisted through the spring. He was placed on the injured list, May 13th, and underwent season-ending surgery a month later.
