For the first three months of the season, the M's floundered between third and fourth of the AL West. However, starting July 2nd, the coxswain of the boat, manager Scott Servais, rallied his team into a consecutive 14-game winning streak which ended the 7th and the Mariners nine games out of first. From the All Star break to the end of the year, Seattle won 39 of 69 games while maintaining second place, thrusting them into the post-season for the first time since 2001. The M's strong oarsmen kept up their pace, swamping the Toronto Blue Jays, 2-0, in a best-of-three Wild Card series before crossing the finish line in the wake of the Houston Astros who swept their Division series, 3-0 (best-of-five). In the two series combined, Eugenio Suarez produced the most at the plate: a .350 BA (7-20), two doubles, a homer, and three RBL. The brightest and most talked about newcomer to the majors, twenty-one-year old Julio Rodriguez, topped off his debut by being named the A. L. Rookie of the Year--his impressive season shows why. His 28 homers led all first-year players and he joined Mike Trout on the short list of rooks in major league history to hit at least 25 home runs, steal 25 bases, and post an .800+ OPS (.853). Adding superior defensive abilities to his resume, Rodriguez finished seventh in league MVP voting. The previously mentioned Suarez was the M's leader with 31 jacks and 87 RBL. Catcher Cal Raleigh hit 27 HRs. Logan Gilbert's 13 wins were the most on the pitching staff. He had 174 strikeouts to Robbie Ray's 212. Ray won 12 ballgames. Marco Gonzales was a disappointing 10-15 with 103 K's.
