**Bucca Bounty:** The Pirates held on as the third place team of the NL Central for about half the season, but it was a division that flaunted the Cardinals and Brewers with everyone else bringing up the rear. A 5 ½ game deficit at the end of April became a 12 ½ game margin from first by the All Star recess. In the year's second half, the Pirates won only 28 of 81 games...A true nugget of the season proved to be rookie Oneil Cruz, a 23-year-old 6' 7" shortstop, who ripped a base hit a tad over 122 mph, the hardest hit ball recorded in STATCAST history. Cruz accounted for 17 home runs, second on the ballclub to Bryan Reynolds's team high 27. Reynolds had the most RBI (62); Cruz drove home 54 in 87 games. Ke'Bryan Hayes hit only seven homers and tallied 41 RBI...The biggest winners on the pitching staff were two relievers, Wil Crowe and Chase De Jong, both with six. The staff strikeout leader was JT Brubaker who punched out 147 batters. He won three times. Starter Mitch Keller won five ballgames while striking out 138 opponents.
