Twins fans enjoyed a season with their hometown nine in the pennant race behind Cleveland and Kansas City right up until September. The ball club entered the last full month in third place a tidy 3 ½ games from the top of the AL Central division. Two wins to open September moved them to second, then the floor dropped out. Post-season hopes were dashed as the team lost 18 of its final 25 games. Their flame out also cost them a Wild Card spot in the playoffs. They finished four games behind the red-hot #3 Tigers (17-8 in September) while the #2 Royals played well enough in the stretch run to claim a position in the post-season tournament...Carlos Santana, playing with a lot of spunk at 38, led the Twins in homers (23) and RBI (71). He was awarded a Gold Glove for his outstanding defense. Ryan Jeffers slugged 21 jacks and drove home 64. Byron Buxton added 18 home runs and 56 RBI...The pitching staff struck out the second-most batters in the majors (1,500). Pablo Lopez was the mound squads biggest winner (15) and tallied the most strikeouts (198). Bailey Ober won 12 games and punched out 191.
