Manager Pedro Grifol was the sacrificial lamb, August 8th, when he was fired with the Sox 28-89 and well on the way to the most losses by any team in modern major league history (from 1901-present). Coach Brady Sizemore finished the season as interim manager. Two consecutive game losing streaks, 14 straight ending June 6th, and a 21-gamer ending in early August, tied the 1988 Orioles for futility. The ball club WON five of its last six games, part of a 10-15 September, their best month of the season...Andrew Benintendi's 20 homers and 64 RBI led the team with the majors worst batting average (.221)...Before he was dealt at the trade deadline, July 29th, Erick Fedde had posted the most wins for the year on the pitching staff (7). Garrett Crochet, coveted by several teams in a trade package, wowed the big leagues with 209 strikeouts, 12.9 per nine innings pitched...Starting third baseman Yoan Moncada played only 11 games the entire year while Luis Robert Jr. had a severe power outage with just 14 homers, 35 RBI, and .224 BA, all well below his excellent 2023 stats: 38 homers, 80 RBI, and .264 BA.
