The A's, participants in the ALCS against the Yankees the previous season, were a .500 team at April's end, four games out of first in the AL West. However, by the All Star break, they had sank to the bottom of the division (6<sup>th</sup>, 12 games out). Billy Martin's brutal overuse of the starting staff the previous two years all but wore out their arms. The hurlers led the majors in walks (648) while the staff ERA ballooned from 3.5 in 1980 and 3.3 in 1981 to 4.54 in 1982. A 9-17 September mercilessly closed the year...There were some bright notes: Rickey Henderson set the major league season record for steals August 27<sup>th</sup>, surpassing Lou Brock's 118 in 1974. His mid-season total was 84. Returning home for his last go-round, Joe Rudi homered in his last at bat, October 3<sup>rd</sup>. Dwayne Murphy was the team leader with 94 RBI. Tony Armas socked 28 homers. Henderson also led the big leagues with 116 walks...The new owners dumped Martin as manager/GM after the season. He was 215-218 over three years...Jose Canseco was drafted in the 15<sup>th</sup> round.
