DOUBLE PLAYS (1871-1932)

Use the results on the out chart with the "DP" suffix.

STRIKEOUTS (ON BATTER'S CARD)

1897-1909, 1882-1888 & 1890 (AA), 1884 (UA)

If the batter's draw for OBA is determined to be an out and the number ends in a zero (10, 20, 30, 40...100), then the batter has struck out. Skip the draw on the out chart.

WILD PITCHES & HIT BATSMEN (ON PITCHERS CARD)

1870'S (NA)

Draw a 1-100 result. If the number is from 1-50, score a wild pitch. If the number is greater than 50 but less than the balk rating, score a hit batsman.

HIT BY PITCH (ON BATTERS CARD)

1871-1875 (NA), 1882-1883 (AA), 1876-1886 (NL)

Simply consider a draw of 100 on the 1-100 batter's draw to be a hit batsmen.
