Several SI Game Club members recommended a new rule for the Pro and College Football Games. We agree with the recommendation and have included it in the new edition of the Rules Booklet. In the meantime, we suggest that you follow this rule in your own games:

The *draw* and the *screen pass* may be used *only once* each in any single series of downs. (After a first down has been made, both plays can be used again, of course.) This more accurately reflects the play of a real game and eliminates the possibility (that some players discovered) of winning by calling nothing but the draw or screen for an entire game.
